1. What is Project Corsair 2026

It is about the History, Heritage, Legacy and Nostalgia of past Glory Days of Northeastern Men's Rowing through a boat that carried its men to unique success. Today, some of those men plan to restore the "Corsair" to its original condition to honor the NU Rowing Heritage.

2. What is the Corsair

The Corsair is a wooden Donoratico Eight oared shell manufactured in the 1960's by the Italian company Cantiere Navale Donoratico and its boat designer Lido Filippi in the city of Donoratico Italy. Donoratico closed in 1979 and Filippi started Filippi Boats in 1980. More history to come.

3. Why is the Corsair Significant to NU Rowing

In 5 short years of use, the Corsair won 6 medals, 2 Gold, 2 Silver, and 2 Bronze medals at the Eastern Sprints and the IRAs. Here's the list:

- Gold – 1V at the 1972 and 1973 Eastern Sprints
- Silver – 2V at the 1975 and 1976 IRA
- Bronze – 1V at the 1973 IRA and at the 1974 Eastern Sprints

- Allow alumni / current athletes the opportunity to row and “feel” the wooden boat legacy.
- Ultimately to display the Corsair at NU for history and legacy significance

5. How Will the Restoration Occur

- Calvin Coffey 74, and Bill Strobel 76, have created the inspiration to restore the Corsair to original beauty. Calvin and Maggie Coffey have secured the help and facilities of the Finger Lakes Boating Museum (<https://www.flbm.org>) to work with NU alumni to restore the boat.
- Volunteers interested in joining the restoration effort will have the opportunity on many weekends that will be scheduled over the many coming months.
- Donations for project costs will be solicited to alumni for interest in support the project.
- Once restoration is complete, alumni and NU will work together to meet the project goals.
